Free auditions will be held for all those interested Saturday, September 29, 2007 from 3 -6 p.m. at Kingsborough Community College in Brooklyn. Those selected to join the cast will be able to participate in the eight performances of "A Winter Fairy Tale," the holiday ballet based on The Nutcracker during the first two weeks of December.

"Registration begins 1/2 hour prior to each audition. Candidates are asked to bring a resume and a headshot."

Created especially for children, "A Winter Fairy Tale" is a charming introduction to ballet and to the timeless tale of The Nutcracker.
