As well as marine iguanas, the giant tortoises of the Galapagos also star in this 5-part series, and part of the filming took place at the Charles Darwin Research Station where David Attenborough discussed the plight of Lonesome George with Felipe Cruz, the Director of Technical Assistance at the CDF.
