

Department of Veteran Affairs has established 5-Year \$50 Million with Lunarline, Inc.

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The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) has established the GSA Blanket Purchase Agreement (BPA) # V200P-1958 for Telecommunication Systems Engineering and Technical Services in support of its infrastructure.

Lunarline was one of four companies selected to help satisfy the BPA requirements on January 25, 2008.

The potential term of the arrangement is 5 years and has a \$50 million dollar ceiling.
