

## **"HENRY MAY LONG", 19th c. independent film from NYC to screen at the LA Femme Film Festival**

*Christian Camargo ("Dexter", "National Treasure: Book of Secrets) stars in "Henry May Long", an independent film with Merchant-Ivory style, screening at the LA Femme Film Festival on 10/16/08 at 10:00AM at the Fine Arts Theatre in Beverly Hills.*

"HENRY MAY LONG", the first feature film from New York theatre director, Randall Sharp, will be screening at the LA Femme Film Festival on October 16, 2008 at 10:00AM at the Fine Arts Theatre in Beverly Hills. "HENRY MAY LONG" is an independent film shot in Connecticut at Mystic Seaport ("Amistad") and the Lockwood-Matthews Mansion ("The Stepford Wives").

In the film Henry May is the self-destructive, golden child of a prominent New York family in 1887. Henry Long is a resourceful, terminally ill entrepreneur. Their chance meeting reveals to both men what they have lost to get where they are, what they are willing to risk to get what they want and what they are willing to lose to live. "Randall Sharp brings late 19th century New York to life... it isn't often that one comes across a smaller feature as ambitious as this..." (Film Threat)

"HENRY MAY LONG" stars Christian Camargo ("Dexter", "National Treasure: Book of Secrets" Broadway's "All My Sons" with Katie Holmes) and has already been included in over 20 film festivals in the U.S., Canada and Europe, winning 13 awards so far (most recently Best Feature & Best Actor at the Sacramento Int'l Film Festival and the ReelHeART Int'l Film Festival in Toronto). Beautifully shot in 35mm and scored by acclaimed composer Max Richter ("Waltz with Bashir", Cannes Film Festival) "HENRY MAY LONG" is an independent film like none other this festival season.
