Djembe the Dog has fervently to increase voter turnout in this election. "So today my brother and I have been at the dog park shaking paws, kissing puppies and trying to get volunteers to know on doggy doors and registering voters" Djembe recently noted on his blog.

Djembe the Dog has not announced his Vice Presidential pick however it is rumored that he will select his brother.

A spokesperson for the Donkey Party discounted Tuffy's and Rusty's platform as "pandering" to potential voters. The spokesperson was quoted as saying the K9P 2008 candidates were simply trying to 'throw humans a few bones' with the commodity price stabilization recommendation.
