Hunger Pains in our Heads is a book that will spark lively discussion, critical debates, and in depth analysis of those events in many classrooms, religious institutions, and political forums.

Annihilator of Innocence is the memoir of author Tahiera Monique Brown. It is her true life story. This book chronicles her life, and her survival, from years of abuse and a myriad of challenging circumstances. Her story culminates with her triumph and survival, against all odds. In addition to being an author, Tahiera is a speaker, and a consultant. She encourages audiences throughout the entire nation. Her message of hope is an inspiration to many people.

The event begins at 11 am on Friday, December 5 and will last until 3 pm. The Birmingham Public Library is located at 2100 Park Place, Birmingham, AL 35203. This event is being sponsored by The Friends of the Birmingham Public Library.
