Ushul of Salafiyyah and Mujaddid (Renovater)of Salafiyyah

Mazhab of Malik was taken from imam Malik, and his followers like Sahnun, Ibn Qasim, Asyhab Al Qaisi, Asad bin Al Farat, Abdul Malik bin Majisyun, Yahya bin Yahya Al Laits, Ishaq bin Al Farat, Asbagh bin Al Faraj, Ibn Wahab, Ibn Abu Zaid Al Qirawani, Ibn Abu Zammun, Al Khalaf bin Abdullah Al Muqri Al Andalusi, Al Qadhi Abdul Wahab Ibn Nashr, Ibn Abdul Barr, Abu Amr Ath Thalamanki, Abu Bakar(Muhammad bin Mawahib who did tahqiq to Risalah of Ibn Abu Zaid), Al Qadhi Isma'il bin Ishaq, Al Qadhi Abu Bakar Al Abhari, Abdullah bin Muhammad Al Qahthani Al Andalusi (the writer of An Nuniyah), Muhammad Amin Asy Syanqithi, Ibn Ghanam Al Ahsa'i, from contemporary Ulama: Muhammad bin Abdul Wahhab.

Mazhab of Asy Syafi'i were taken from Imam Asy Syafi'i, and his followers: Al Buwaithi, Al Muzani, Ibn Hibban, Ibn Khuzaimah, Ibn Khafif, Al Hakim, Ibn Suraih, Ibn Shalah, Ibn Nuhas (Harmalah bin Yahya), Al Azhari, Al Lughawi, Ibn Abu Hatim, Ibnu Tsamamah, Al Baghawi, Ibn Katsir, Al Hafizh Ibn Hajar Al Asqalani, Ad Daruquthni, Al Humaidi, Ibn Sunni, Abul Hasan Al Asy'ari, Abul Abbas Al Asham, Al Mazi, As Saji, Utsman bin Sa'id Ad Darami, Al Lalika'i, Muhammad bin Nashr Al Maruzi, Al Muqrizi, Al Mundziri, Abu Muhammad Al Juwaini.

Imam ahlus Sunnah from Imam Mazhab Syafi'i who fought Bid'ah: Al Baihaqi, Al Khittabi, Abu Nua'im Al Ashbahani, Al Izz bin Abdus Salam, An Nawawi, As Suyuthi, Al Manawi.

Mazhab of Abu Hanifah were taken from imam Abu Hanifah and his students Ishaq bin Rahawiyah and Muhammad bin Syaibani, Abu Sulaiman (Musa bin Sulaiman Al Jauzajaini) died in 200 H, Ma'la bin Manshur Ar Razi died in 211 H, Syaddad bin Hakim Al Qadhi Al Makki died in 213 H, Hisyam bin Ubaidillah bin Razi died in 221 H, Al Laits bin Mushawir Al Balkhi died in 226 H, Yahya bin Aktsam At Tamimi Al Qadhi, Muhammad bin Ahmad bin Hafsh Az Zarqani died in 264 H, Al Hakam bin Ma'bad Al Khaza'i died in 295 H, Abu Ja'far Ahmad bin Muhammad Ath Thahawi died in 321 H, Ibn Abu Al Izz Ad Damsyiqi Al Hanafi died in 712 H, Ahmad bin Abdul Ahad Al Faruqi As Sahrandi died in 1034 H, Abul Barkat Khairuddin Nu'man Al Alusi died in 1252 H, Mahmud Syukri bin Abdullah Al Alusi, Muhammad Shiddiq Khan bin Hasan Al Bukhari Al Fanuji died in 1307 H, Muhammad Basyir bin Muhammad Badruddin As Sahwani Al Hindi died in 1326 H, Muhammad Isma'il bin Abdul Ghani bin Waliyullah Ad Dahlawi died in 1381 H, Al Ma'shumi Al Hanafi, Al Barnawi Al Hanafi, Abul Wafa' Ad Darwisy.

Mazhab Ahmad was taken from Imam Ahmad bin Hanbal, Abdullah bin Ahmad bin Hanbal, Muflih bin Abdullah, Yahya bin Sa'id Al Qathan, Ibn Taimiyyah, Syamsuddin bin Q. Al Jauziyyah, Ibnul Jauzi.

Salafiyyah follows the Ushul of Abu Hanifah (80-150 H), Al Faqih in Iraq, Abu Hanifah An Nu'man bin Tsaabit bin Zauthi At Taimi Al Kufi.

And follows Ushul of Imam Malik (93-179 H) Abu Abdullah Malik bin Anas bin Malik Al Ashbahi Al Madani, from Hijaz, he was Al Hafiizh, Al Faqih, Imam Darul Hijrah.

And follows the Ushul of Imam Al Auza'i in Syam(Jordan or or Syria or Libanon or Palestine),Abu Umar Abdurrahman bin Amr bin Muhammad.

And follows the Ushul of Imam Laits bin Sa'ad, Abul Haarits Al Fahmi Al Ashbahani Al Mishri (died in 175 H), Al Haafizh and Al Faqiih in Egypt.

And follows the Ushul of Imam Sufyan Ats Tsauri in Iraq (died in 169 H),Amirul Mukminin of Al Hadits, Abu Abdullah Sufyan bin Sa'id bin Masruuq Ats Tsauri.

And follows the Ushul of Imam Asy Syafi'i, Abu Abdullah Muhammad bin Idris bin Abbas bin Asy Syafi'i bin As Saiib, bin 'Ubaid bin 'Abdi Yaziid bin Hasyiim bin Muthallib bin Abdi Manaf bin Qusyai bin Kilab Al Qurasyi Al Muthallibi Asy Syafi'i (Ulama zaman and Al Faqiih, the descendant of Rasulullah and Mujaddid of 2th century Hijriah).

And follows the Ushul of Imam Ahmad (Al Haafizh and Al Hujjatul Islam), Abu Abdillah bin Muhammad bin Hambal bin Hilal Asas Asy Syaibani Adz Dzihli Al Marwazi.

And follows the Ushul of Imam Abu Ya'qub Ishaq bin Ibrahim bin Mukhallad bin Ibrahim Al Marwazi or Ibn Zahuwiyah (died in 238 H), Al Hafiizh kabir and Syaikh in Iraq.

And follows the Ushul of Imam Abu 'Ubaid Qasim bin Abdus Salaam Al Baghdadi,died in Makkah 224H (Al Mujtahid, Al Haafizh in Al Hadits, language expert, Imam in Qira'at).

And also following Imam Az Zuhri and Sufyan bin Uyainah.
