

## **Do's & Don'ts When Purchasing Motorcycle Leathers Online.**

*Buying leather motorcycle jackets and biker apparel online can be fun and save you money if you follow these do's & don'ts from Primal Leathers.*

Do ask what type of leather it is made from.

There are several kinds of leathers which are commonly used to make motorcycle jackets and biker apparel. The quality will vary greatly depending on the type of leather and the manufacturing process involved. It's important to read the item descriptions carefully and ask questions if you're not sure.

Don't assume they are all the same quality.

Shopping for motorcycle leathers online can be very rewarding because of the time and money you save compared to going to your local, or not so local, leather store. The flip side is you can't touch or try the item on before you purchase. That's why it's necessary to fully research the products before you buy. This may seem obvious but there are so many online leather stores selling, what appears to be, the same items that sometimes its hard to tell the good from the bad.

Do your homework.

On the blog page at <http://www.primalleathers.com> you will find explanations for the different types of leather used in the making of leather apparel. If you are still not sure please feel free to call or email us and we will be happy to answer all your questions.

Do read the item descriptions carefully.

Some leather dealers will describe a product as being made of genuine leather, leading you to believe its cow, when in fact it could be pig leather or water buffalo, nether of which will last long if gotten wet or offer much protection in case of an accident.

Do choose your leather items for the purpose they are intended.

Some leather products are made from scraps of thin leather, or patches, sewn together and others are comprised of chopped leather pressed together with an adhesive. These types of leather apparel are not very durable and not recommended when protection is a must. They would be more suitable for casual wear, not for motorcycle riding.

Don't order until you check the sizing instructions.

Depending on where the leather products are manufactured, they could vary greatly in size differences. Always read the sizing charts and information carefully before ordering.

At <http://www.primalleathers.com> we will always call to confirm that the order was in fact yours and at this time we will double check the size to insure a great fit.

Do check the privacy, security, guarantee and return policies to insure a safe and comfortable transaction. Nobody wants to have problems with their order and if there are any you want to be able to resolve them without any hassle.

Don't make a blind purchase.

Log on to [Rip Off Report.com](http://RipOffReport.com) or some other consumer report forums and check to see if there are any negative reports against the company BEFORE you close the deal. This could save you countless hours of aggravation.
