Georgia Tech Team Report

Even though No. 11 Georgia Tech is coming off its biggest win in years—fans tore down the goalposts after the 28-23 upset of Virginia Tech—the Yellow Jackets should have no trouble focusing on Virginia.

“I don’t think we’ll have a problem staying focused,” coach Paul Johnson said. “A year ago, we were 6-1 and a two-touchdown favorite against the same team (Virginia), and they came in here and smacked us in the mouth. It shouldn’t be a surprise that Virginia will come to play; they sit atop the division standings. We know where we’re at. Our backs are against the wall.”

The Cavaliers are the kind of disciplined, smash-mouth team that can give Tech problems.

“They have reverted back to what they used to do,” Johnson said. “They scrapped the new offense; they’re back to running the same offense they ran forever under Al (Groh), and they stopped turning the ball over. They were a turnover a minute earlier in the year. They weren’t giving themselves a chance to play, but the last three games they have created turnovers. They’ve taken care of the ball, and that’s the difference between winning and losing. When you look statistically, they’ve been pretty good defensively

the whole time, but they couldn't survive the turnovers.”

Virginia Team Report

The Cavaliers (3-3, 2-0 ACC) are the only unbeaten team in conference play.

But their opponent on Saturday is one of the frontrunners for the ACC title.

Georgia Tech (6-1, 4-1) visits Virginia on Oct. 24 in a Coastal Division showdown. And while Cavaliers head coach Al Groh is certainly glad to be unbeaten in conference play, he recognizes what Georgia Tech has done is far more impressive.

“They’ve passed a lot more tests than we have,” Groh said of the Yellow Jackets, who are entering their sixth conference game.

Still, Virginia is a confident bunch. The Cavaliers are on a three-game winning streak after an 0-3 start, and they’ve won 12 of their past 13 October games.

Senior linebacker Denzel Burrell said the team is careful not to get overconfident about its hot streak.
