(1) Anniversary Gemstones - The Traditional Anniversary Gift by Year

Certain wedding anniversaries are traditionally linked to particular gemstones or precious metals. These milestones offer the perfect opportunity to surprise her with a piece of fine jewellery - pearl pendants make excellent pearl anniversary gifts, while ruby drop earrings are perfect for a ruby wedding anniversary. The British anniversaries are listed below.

- 18th wedding anniversary Coloured Gemstone Jewellery
- 25th wedding anniversary Silver Jewellery
- 30th wedding anniversary- Pearl Jewellery
- 40th wedding anniversary Ruby Jewellery
- 45th wedding anniversary Sapphire Jewellery
- 50th wedding anniversary Emerald Jewellery
- 60th wedding anniversary Diamond Jewellery

(2) Trilogy Jewellery

Three Stone Rings, Pendants or Earrings representing the Past, Present and Future Jewellery set with a trio of diamonds or gemstones is referred to as Trilogy jewellery, the three precious stones representing the past, present and future.

Rings with three diamonds are particularly popular, but there's no reason to limit it to rings. Jewellery such as pendants, earrings or even bracelets with three diamonds set in trilogy style can offer a contemporary alternative.

(3) Eternity Rings

The name says it all! Although traditionally given on the birth of a couple's first child, eternity rings are increasingly being given as a wedding anniversary present since they represent commitment to be together forever.

Moreover eternity rings are ultra versatile, since they can be worn either near a diamond engagement ring or separately on the right hand. Diamond eternity rings are a classic, and there are many more colourful alternatives set with rubies, emeralds, sapphires or even tanzanite gemstones.

(4) Promise Rings

Promise Rings often take the place of engagement rings where a couple do not intend to marry imminently, but can be given on any occasion. They are particularly good as first wedding anniversary gifts.

In terms of style, a small solitaire diamond ring would work, as would a two stone diamond ring, with the two diamonds representing the couple. There is however a lot of flexibility in style - the "promise" aspect comes in with the words or presentation of the ring rather than the ring itself.

(5) Gold Lockets and Diamond Lockets

A perennial favourite, a gold locket or diamond locket containing photos of you and your loved one is sure to please. A classic and sure to transcend the years, a heart shaped gold locket will go with almost any outfit, while a modern white gold diamond locket can be worn out at night with the photos inside being almost a hidden message from the world.

(6) Diamond Jewellery representing your years together

Match the carat weight of the jewellery to the number of years you have been married, or to the year of your wedding.

For example, if you were married in 1983, you could choose a piece of jewellery that is set with 0.83 carats of diamonds, representing the year. Alternatively you could choose something with 0.27 carats of diamonds to represent 27 years together.

This offers you a lot of flexibility in terms of what type of jewellery (rings, earrings, pendants, necklaces, brooches or bracelets) to buy. In addition, the subtlety of the meaning behind the piece means that only you and your partner will know it, emphasising the romantic nature of the gift.

(7) Diamond Jewellery to match her Engagement Ring

A diamond engagement ring is probably the single most poignant item of jewellery, other than a wedding ring, that a woman will ever own. Make her day by selecting a solitaire diamond pendant, a pair of diamond earrings or a diamond bangle with the same colour of gold and cut of diamond as her engagement ring. She'll be able to wear the pendant or earrings effortlessly with her diamond ring, whether during the day or on special occasions, and will be astounded by your attention to detail!

(8) Colour Gemstone Jewellery

If you want a splash of colour, you could choose a gemstone that matches the colour scheme of your wedding, or even her eyes. If the bridesmaids wore green, choose emeralds, peridots or green amethysts. If they wore pink, a pink sapphire or tourmaline item would be perfect. Explain your choice and you're sure to earn some extra brownie points.

(9) Journey Pendant or Earrings

A pendant or earrings set with a row of diamonds graduating in size or following a twisting path can be seen as a Journey Pendant or Journey Earrings. The meaning behind this is clear - you've been on a journey

together and will continue on that path. Beautiful jewellery with an underlying heartfelt message.

(10) Hearts, Flowers or Kisses

A heart diamond pendant, a bracelet with gold shaped into kisses, or floral jewellery are all great choices for romantic and feminine women. These are the ultimate in romantic gifts - and perfect not just for anniversaries but also Valentine's Day or "Just Because"!
