1. Dentists do not need special training or certification to do dental implants. A dental professional is not required to complete much training in order to do dental implants. In fact, many dentists (in the US as well as in Mexico and other countries) may have only completed a one-day seminar offered by an implant product manufacturer. That's ALL they need to do implants. They do not need any serious training, additional certification or professional education. In fact, many may have only completed a weekend seminar offered by an implant product manufacturer.
2. Patients can save a lot of money by having their implants done in a foreign country like Mexico. Because of lower overhead and labor costs in Mexico, patients can save between 40 to 60 per cent of what the procedure would cost in the US. Many Mexico Dental implant specialists and Dentists in Mexico have been doing implants and other procedures for much longer and more successfully than many of the dentists in the US who have recently added this procedure to the list of what they can do in their office.
3. Experience is very important! Not everyone can do implants well. If a patient is considering dental implants, they should need to find someone with surgical and prosthetic implant experience - especially if they have severe periodontal disease or if they need multiple implants. Inserting Dental Implants is a highly technical and sensitive surgical and prosthetic treatment which requires a high level of expertise.
4. There are risks for dental implants if not done correctly. These include local and systemic infection, nerve injury and the possibly that there might be "inadvertent perforation of the nasal sinus." These can be serious life threatening complications.
5. Patients do not have to wait six to eight months to get teeth after the initial implant surgery. Most inexperienced dentists will want patients to wait six to eight months after they insert the implants before attaching "permanent" teeth to the implants. While they wait for the implants to heal, the patient will have to wear dentures. Not only are temporary dentures often very uncomfortable, awkward and expensive, it is often much healthier for the mouth to get what is known as "immediate loading" or "Same Day Dental Implants". Not only does it look better, "Immediate loading" enables implants to heal without the discomfort of dentures. Dentures often have to be refitted several times to correct sore spots that develop. Also, by maintaining pressure on the bone via the "temporary bridge", it encourages bone growth. Jawbones need the "exercise" from chewing and eating to maintain their health and consistency.

What do you need to ask your dentist before you get dental implants

What type of training did you get? Formal 3-year specialty, or just weekend seminars?

How long have you been doing implants?

How many implants have you done?

How often do you place or restore implants?

What is your success rate?

To prevent something going wrong or to avoid experiencing serious complications, patients should only use a dental implant specialist with years of experience and extensive training and certification. Also, if possible, check their credentials and talk to a few happy patients.
