For example, there's a physician from California named Dr. Frankenstein. The real-life Dr. Frankenstein penned the book's foreword: "For those of us with distinctive surnames, Wacky News Names will reassure that many others feel our pain," says Richard Frankenstein, MD, an internist.

There are among the 700-plus names featured in *Wacky News Names*, along with inventively-drawn sketches from cartoonist Anthony Schmidt.

Busalacchi is a writer, public relations specialist and former Wisconsin Public Radio reporter. It was during his WPR days in the mid-1980s that this name-collecting hobby began.
