In addition to several important meetings, Language Systems representatives took some time to see some of the sights around Beijing, such as Tiananmen Square, the Forbidden City and the Great Wall. They also had a chance to sample a variety of traditional Chinese dishes and experience the hospitality of the Chinese people. “I’m glad that we came to China to meet with such knowledgeable and hospitable people related to international study.
