However, many couples aren't really sure what they should be doing once they have them printed and ready to mail. They have lots of questions, including who receives them, when they hit the mailbox and what they should say in the first place. Here are some suggestions and helpful hints.

Marriage announcements, as you may have already discovered, are usually purchased along with the rest of your stationery package. However, they do not get mailed in advance like your invitations. The general rule is that your wedding announcement cards,

<http://www.announcements-shoppe.com/Wedding-Invitations-Wedding-Announcements-Cards/productsList-3-1.htm> should go in the mail the day of or the day after the actual ceremony. Basically, you don't want to announce anything that might end up being changed by a last minute delay.

Before you reach that point, you'll need to figure out how many photo marriage cards or wedding invitations, <http://www.cardsshoppe.com/wedding-invitations/> to order. That's probably one of the easier decision. When you're making your original list of who to invite, you probably remember there being some people who weren't included on the list but who were given consideration. These are all people who should receive reception announcements. Basically, you should send the wedding invitations, <http://www.express-invitations.com/wedding-invitations/> and wedding reception announcement to anyone who is not invited to your wedding but who you might have invited if you'd had more room or more budget available.

If you're concerned about how to word your wedding reception announcements, don't worry too much. The content is very similar to what you already have prepared for your invitations. The information you want to include will be your names, the date and location of the marriage, and your parents' names. There's no reason to let guests know that you are registered somewhere for gifts. Yes, some people who receive weddings announce will send a present but don't make it sound mandatory. Be sure you have enough thank you cards to accommodate these extra gifts as well.

Other Important Points about Wedding Announcement Cards

The Wedding announcement is a nice way of letting people know about your marriage but they are even more essential if you are not having a large wedding or if you are having a destination wedding with only a few people attending. You want to let everyone in your family know about your wedding even if they can't actually come to the event.

If you don't want to worry about sending the marriage announcements,

<http://www.announcements-shoppe.com/cards> on your wedding day or on the first day of your honeymoon, make sure you have them all ready to go and turn them over to a trusted member of the wedding party, possibly the bride or the mother or the maid of honor. It would be nice to purchase special stamps for the announcements just like you might use for your invitations. The post office sells these new "Love" stamps every year which are perfect for wedding announcement cards.
