A wide variety of massage specialties are included in the new directory. Swedish massage helps stimulate circulation, frees adhesions, decreases swelling, releases tension, and relaxes the whole body. Foot reflexology follows the theory that the foot connects via nerves and meridians to particular organs and body parts, so when the feet are being rubbed the rest of the body benefits. Shiatsu is a Japanese massage method where points are held along the meridians (energy pathways) then rocking or stretching the meridians, to increase the circulation and increase the energy along that pathway. Aromatherapy is an ayurvedic technique that uses the pure essential oils derived from plants to aid in the healing process. Reiki is a non-invasive technique that works between the spiritual, mental, and physical levels.

Sports massage is recommended for people that have strenuous workouts or sporting events, and to help athletes perform at their highest capacity by increasing circulation and mobility. Trigger point therapy focuses on irritable spots in the muscle tissue that contribute critically to pain. Somatic technique stretches specific muscle groups to release chronically tight muscles. Deep tissue massage is an advanced Swedish technique, which specifically addresses the deeper layers of muscle tissue.

Acupressure is a Chinese method that follows the acupuncture meridians, holding certain arrangements of points along the meridians so that the body will open up and allow for the healing to begin. Hawaiian lomi lomi is a massage technique that involves pounding muscle tissue. Hot towel treatments may be used, where steaming hot towels are wrapped or placed on a body part: feet, back, neck, face
