A Concord resident, Merlino sits on the Board of Directors for the Concord Chamber of Commerce and is owner of Concord Bike Tours, a local tour company. Other community involvement in the program comes from Concord Lumber, which donated the materials used during the show.

"In the spirit of neighbors helping neighbors, we hope this new show gives local homeowners the inspiration they need to fix a few things around their home," said CCTV's Merlino. "In fact, the show is reminiscent of the early days of This Old House. Rob's such a straight-shooter, and his instructions are so easy to follow that anyone who watches is sure to be comfortable taking on a few simple projects around the house."

In addition to offering home improvement and remodeling advice on his blog, Robillard is an accomplished finish carpenter and general contractor. In recent months, he has expanded his blog to include a steady stream of tool reviews for those ready for the next step in their DIY careers.
